Commissioner Walls announced that it was nice to see a lot of people come out to watch the arrival of the Big Boy Train. The event helped small businesses out.

Under new business, Nicole Thomas, Prothonotary, requested Consideration of Approval of RSVP Program. Brian Wiser, Vice President/Director of Transportation Keller Engineers, requested Consideration of Approval for A DCED MTF Grant Application for replacement of the roof system on County Bridge No.8. Commissioner Reeder commented that he appreciated Keller Engineers for doing this and without them writing this application it probably wouldn't have been done. Commissioner Reeder also added that this is a great savings and putting a roof on it for \$25,000 is pretty good. 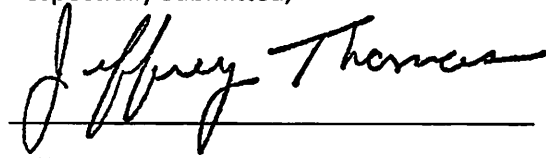
There were no Matters for Action.
